

Scholarships, Mini Grants & Community Engagement Funding

• A total of \$6,869.98 was awarded in Scholarships during the quarter that directly paid for textbooks, connect/access card, tool kits for automotive and truck driving.



- A total of \$1200 was awarded via Mini-Grant requests submitted by Faculty
