Your 2025-2026 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) was selected for review in a process called verification. The law says that if you are selected for verification, we are required to ask you to confirm the information you, your spouse (if married), and your parents/stepparents (if dependent) reported on your FAFSA before awarding Federal Student Aid. To verify that you provided correct information, the Financial Aid Office will compare your FAFSA with the information on this worksheet and with any other required documentation. If there are differences, your FAFSA information may need to be corrected. You and at least one parent/stepparent (if dependent) must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documentation, and submit the form and other required documentation to the Financial Aid Office. If additional information is required, we will contact you.
